Section 1. (a) All law enforcement agencies in this state shall adopt

written policies regarding calls involving persons in crisis who are living with mental illness as provided in subsection (b). These policies shall be made available to all officers of such agency.

16 Such written policies shall include, but not be limited to, the 17 (b)

following:

A statement describing the responding officers' responsibilities and procedures to follow when responding to a call involving persons in crisis who are living with mental illness;

current contact information for resource agencies within the community, including, but not limited to, the community mental health center; and

- (3)guidelines that describe to responding officers signs and symptoms to recognize persons in crisis who are living with mental illness.
- Such written policies shall be adopted on or before January 1, 2009.
- (d) All law enforcement agencies shall provide training to officers on recognizing and responding to crisis calls involving persons living with mental illness.
- (e) No law enforcement agency or employee of such agency acting within the scope of employment shall be liable for damages resulting from the adoption or enforcement of any policy adopted under this section, unless a duty of care, independent of such policy, is owed to the specific individual injured.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
