9 AN ACT concerning electric rates; providing for statewide uniform rates
10 for retail electric customers by customer class.

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12 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

13 Section 1. (a) All retail electric customers in Kansas who are in the
14 same customer class shall pay a uniform rate for electrical service as de-
15 termined by the state corporation commission pursuant to this section.
16 Any amounts for goods or services other than electric service paid for by
17 the customer shall not be included in the uniform rate and shall be as-
18 sessed by the supplier separately from assessment of such rate.

19 (b) Each retail electric supplier, as defined in K.S.A. 66-1,170, and
20 amendments thereto, shall report monthly to the state corporation com-
21 mission such information as required by the commission in order to com-
22 pute a statewide uniform rate for the preceding month for all electric
23 customers in Kansas who are in the same customer class. The uniform
24 rate shall not include any amounts charged for goods or services other
25 than electric service paid for by the customer but shall include amounts
26 expended by retail electric suppliers for energy conservation measures or
27 programs found by the commission to be cost effective.

28 (c) The state corporation commission shall establish a method for
29 collecting and redistributing monthly moneys collected by retail electric
30 suppliers pursuant to the statewide uniform rate so that each supplier
31 receives revenue equal to: (1) The supplier's revenue requirements and
32 approved rate of return, as determined by the commission, in the case of
33 a for-profit public utility the rates of which are regulated by the commis-
34 sion; (2) the supplier's revenue requirements, as determined by the com-
35 mission, in the case of a nonprofit public utility the rates of which are
36 regulated by the commission; or (3) the supplier's revenue requirements,
37 as determined and certified to the commission by the supplier's governing
38 body, in the case of a supplier the rates of which are not regulated by the
39 commission.

40 (d) At least every two years the state corporation commission shall
41 conduct an audit of the revenue requirements of each retail electric sup-
42 plier the rates of which are not regulated by the commission to determine
43 the validity of the requirements certified to the commission by the gov-

1 ernal body of the supplier.

2 (e) The state corporation commission shall adopt rules and regula-
3 tions to implement the provisions of this section.

4 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
5 publication in the statute book.
