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AN ACT concerning the department on aging; relating to the senior serv-11 12ices fund; creating the health care for seniors fund; disposition of cer-13 tain additional lottery proceeds; prescribing certain powers, duties and 14functions for the secretary of aging; amending K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 74-158768 and repealing the existing section. 1617Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 18New Section 1. (a) There is hereby established in the state treasury 19the health care for seniors fund which shall be administered by the sec-20retary of aging as provided by law. 21All moneys credited to the health care for seniors fund shall be (b) 22 used for additional funding for health care programs, assistance and serv-23 ices for seniors. Moneys allocated or appropriated from the health care 24 for seniors fund shall not be used to replace or substitute for moneys 25appropriated from the state general fund in the immediately preceding 26fiscal year. All expenditures from the health care for seniors fund shall be 27 made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director 28of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the 29 secretary of aging or the secretary's designee. 30 (c) On or before the 10th day of each month, the director of accounts 31and reports shall transfer from the state general fund to the health care 32 for seniors fund interest earnings based on (1) the average daily balance 33 of moneys in the health care for seniors fund and (2) the net earnings 34 rate of the pooled money investment portfolio for the preceding month. 35 (d) As used in this section, "senior" means an individual who resides 36 in Kansas, who is 60 years of age or older and who is in need of health 37 care. 38 New Sec. 2. During the 2008 regular session and during each regular 39 session thereafter, the legislature shall specify by appropriation act an amount or amounts of moneys to be transferred by the director of ac-40 41counts and reports from the expanded lottery act revenues fund to the 42health care for seniors fund established by section 1, and amendments 43 thereto, or to the senior services fund established by subsection (g) of HB 2866

1 K.S.A. 75-4265, and amendments thereto, or to both such funds, in ac-2 cordance with this section. Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 2007 3 Supp. 74-8768, and amendments thereto, or any other statute, the director of accounts and reports shall transfer the amount or amounts as spec-4 ified or otherwise prescribed by appropriation act of the legislature, on $\mathbf{5}$ the date or dates specified therefor, from the expanded lottery act reve-6 7 nues fund to the health care for seniors fund established by section 1, 8 and amendments thereto, or to the senior services fund established by 9 subsection (g) of K.S.A. 75-4265, and amendments thereto, or to both such funds, all in accordance with the provisions of appropriation acts. 10 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 74-8768 is hereby amended to read as 11 12follows: 74-8768. There is hereby created the expanded lottery act reve-13 nues fund in the state treasury. All expenditures and transfers from such fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts. All moneys 1415credited to such fund shall be expended or transferred only for the pur-16poses of reduction of state debt, state infrastructure improvements and, reduction of local ad valorem tax in the same manner as provided for 1718allocation of amounts in the local ad valorem tax reduction fund, health 19care programs, assistance and services for seniors for which expenditures 20may be made from the health care for seniors fund established by section 211, and amendments thereto, and projects and purposes for which expend-22 itures may be made from the senior services fund established by subsection 23 (g) of K.S.A. 75-4265, and amendments thereto. 24 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 74-8768 is hereby repealed. 25Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
