9 AN ACT concerning schools; relating to incentive programs.

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11 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

12 Section 1. (a) As used in this section, “school district” means any
13 school district, school district interlocal cooperative, school district co-
14 operative or nonpublic school accredited by the state board of education.

15 (b) The national school psychology certification incentive program is
16 hereby established for the purpose of rewarding school psychologists who
17 have attained certification from the national association of school psy-
18 chologists. School psychologists who have attained certification from the
19 national association and who are employed by a school district shall be
20 paid an incentive bonus in the amount of \$1,000 each school year that
21 the school psychologist remains employed by a school district and retains
22 a valid certification from the national association of school psychologists.

23 (c) Each school district employing one or more national association
24 certified school psychologists shall pay the incentive bonus to each such
25 school psychologist in each school year that the school psychologist retains
26 eligibility for such payment. Each board of education which has made
27 payments of incentive bonuses to national association certified school psy-
28 chologists under this subsection may file an application with the state
29 board of education for state aid and shall certify to the state board the
30 amount of such payments. The application and certification shall be on a
31 form prescribed and furnished by the state board, shall contain such in-
32 formation as the state board shall require and shall be filed at the time
33 specified by the state board.

34 (d) In each school year, each school district employing one or more
35 national association certified school psychologists is entitled to receive
36 from state appropriations for the national school psychology certification
37 incentive program an amount which is equal to the amount certified to
38 the state board of education in accordance with the provisions of subsec-
39 tion (c). The state board shall certify to the director of accounts and
40 reports the amount due each school district. The director of accounts and
41 reports shall draw warrants on the state treasurer payable to the treasurer
42 of each school district entitled to payment under this section upon vouch-
43 ers approved by the state board.

1 (e) Moneys received by a board of education under this section shall
2 be deposited in the general fund of the school district and shall be con-
3 sidered reimbursements to the district for the purpose of the school dis-
4 trict finance and quality performance act and may be expended whether
5 the same have been budgeted or not.

6 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
7 publication in the statute book.
