AN ACT concerning civil procedure; relating to wrongful death; amend-1011ing K.S.A. 60-1903 and repealing the existing section. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 60-1903 is hereby amended to read as follows: 60-151903. (a) In any wrongful death action, the court or jury may award such 16damages as are found to be fair and just under all the facts and circum-17stances, but the damages, other than pecuniary loss sustained by an heir 18at law, cannot exceed in the aggregate the sum of \$250,000 and costs. 19(b) If a wrongful death action is to a jury, the court shall not instruct 20the jury on the monetary limitation imposed by subsection (a) upon re-21covery of damages for nonpecuniary loss. If the jury verdict results in an 22award of damages for nonpecuniary loss which, after deduction of any 23 amounts pursuant to K.S.A. 60-258a and amendments thereto, exceeds 24 the limitation of subsection (a), the court shall enter judgment for dam-25ages of \$250,000 for nonpecuniary loss. 26In any wrongful death action, the verdict shall be itemized by the (c) 27 trier of fact to reflect the amounts, if any, awarded for: 28(1)Nonpecuniary damages; 29 (2)expenses for the care of the deceased caused by the injury; and 30 (3)pecuniary damages other than those itemized under subsection 31 (c)(2).32 (d) Where applicable, the amounts required to be itemized pursuant 33 to subsections (c)(1) and (c)(3) shall be further itemized by the trier of 34 fact to reflect those amounts awarded for injuries and losses sustained to 35 date and those awarded for injuries and losses reasonably expected to be 36 sustained in the future. 37 (e) In any wrongful death action, the trial court shall instruct the jury 38 only on those items of damage upon which there is some evidence to base 39 an award. 40 In any wrongful death action, the court or jury may award such (f)41damages as are found to be fair and just under all the facts and 42circumstances.

43 (g) The provisions of subsections (a), (b), (c) and (d) shall apply only

1 to a wrongful death action based upon a cause of action accruing on or

2 before June 30, 2008. The provisions of subsection (f) shall apply only to
