9 AN ACT creating and implementing the fatherhood initiative program; 10 relating to the duties of the department of social and rehabilitation 11services. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. (a) Subject to the provisions of appropriation acts, the sec-15retary of social and rehabilitation services shall establish a fatherhood 16 initiative program within the department of social and rehabilitation serv-17ices. The objectives of the initiative shall be to: 18(1) Promote public education concerning the financial and emotional 19responsibilities of fatherhood; 20(2)assist men in preparation for the legal, financial and emotional 21responsibilities of fatherhood; 22 promote the establishment of paternity at childbirth; (3)23 encourage fathers, regardless of marital status, to foster their emo-(4)24 tional connection to and financial support of their children; 25establish support mechanisms for fathers in their relationship with (5)26their children, regardless of their marital and financial status; 27 (6)integrate state and local services available for families; and 28(7)promote, foster, encourage and otherwise support programs de-29 signed to educate and train young men who are both current and future 30 fathers as to effective parenting skills, behaviors and attitudes. 31 (b) The secretary, on or before the first day of the regular legislative 32 session, shall report annually to the legislature: 33 (1)The number of fathers and children participating in the program; 34 (2)an overview of any moneys spent on the program; and 35 (3)the cost-savings analysis of implementing the program by having 36 children build and retain a relationship with their father. 37 The secretary may adopt any rules and regulations necessary to (\mathbf{c}) 38 implement the provisions of this section. 39 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 40publication in the statute book.
