9 AN ACT concerning insurance; relating to coverage for hospital, medical 10 and surgical services in a cancer clinical trial; amending K.S.A. 2007 11Supp. 40-2,103 and 40-19c09 and repealing the existing sections. 12 13 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14New Section 1. (a) On or after the effective date of this act, every 15health insurer which issues a health benefit plan providing medical, sur-16gical or hospital expense coverage shall provide that the amount paid for 17providing covered medical, surgical or hospital services to an insured shall 18be the same whether or not such provider providing the covered medical, 19surgical or hospital services is a participating provider, belonging to such 20health insurer's provider network. 21The payment required by subsection (a) shall not adversely affect (b) 22 the insured's deductible or copayment under such health benefit plan. 23 The coverage required by this section shall be subject to the same (c) 24 annual deductibles, copayments or coinsurance limits as established for 25all other covered benefits under the individual or group policy of accident 26and sickness insurance referred to in subsection (a). 27 (d) For the purposes of this section: 28(1)"Health benefit plan" shall have the meaning ascribed to it in 29 K.S.A. 40-4602 and amendments thereto. 30 "Health insurer" shall have the meaning ascribed to it in K.S.A. (2)40-4602 and amendments thereto. 31 32 (3)"Provider" shall have the meaning ascribed to it in K.S.A. 40-4602 33 and amendments thereto. 34 "Participating provider" shall have the meaning ascribed to it in (4)35 K.S.A. 40-4602 and amendments thereto. 36 A health benefit plan shall provide notice to each insured or en-(e) 37 rollee under such plan regarding the coverage required by this section in 38 the plan's evidence of coverage and shall provide additional written notice 39 of the coverage to the insured or enrollee as follows: 40 In the next mailing made by the plan to the insured or enrolled (1)41employee; 42as part of any yearly informational packet sent to the enrollee; or (2)43 (3)not later than December 1, 2008, whichever is earlier.

1 (f) The provisions of this act shall apply to all health benefit plans 2 issued or delivered within this state on or after January 1, 2009, and to 3 all health benefit plans in effect before January 1, 2009, which are re-4 newed or amended on or after January 1, 2009. (g) The provisions of this section shall not apply to any policy or cer-5tificate which provides coverage for any specified disease, specified ac-6 7 cident or accident only coverage, credit, dental, disability income, hospital indemnity, long-term care insurance as defined by K.S.A. 40-2227, and 8 amendments thereto, vision care or any other limited supplemental ben-9 efit nor to any medicare supplement policy of insurance as defined by 10 the commissioner of insurance by rule and regulation, any coverage issued 11 12as a supplement to liability insurance, workers' compensation or similar 13 insurance, automobile medical-payment insurance or any insurance under which benefits are payable with or without regard to fault, whether 1415written on a group, blanket or individual basis. 16The provisions of this section shall apply to the Kansas state em-(h) ployee health care benefits program and municipal funded pools. 1718(i) The provisions of K.S.A. 40-2249a, and amendments thereto, shall 19not apply to the provisions of this section. 20Sec. 2. 1 code except as expressly provided in this act.

2 (b) No policy, agreement, contract or certificate issued by a corpo-

3 ration to which this section applies shall contain a provision which ex-

4 cludes, limits or otherwise restricts coverage because medicaid benefits
5 as permitted by title XIX of the social security act of 1965 are or may be

6 available for the same accident or illness.

7 (c) Violation of subsection (b) shall be subject to the penalties pre- 8 scribed by K.S.A. 40-2407 and 40-2411, and amendments thereto.

9 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 40-2,103 and 40-19c09 are hereby 10 repealed.
