## HOUSE BILL No. 2973

#### Abstract

AN ACT concerning elections; relating to certain primary elections; amending K.S.A. 25-2021, 25-2108a and 71-1415 and repealing the existing sections.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. K.S.A. 25-2021 is hereby amended to read as follows: 252021. (a) In sehool distriets in which a member district method of election is in effeet, if there are more than (2) qualified candidates for one (1) member position in any member distriet, the county election officer shall eall, and there shall be held, a primary election in each sueh member distriet and, if there are more than two (2) qualified eandidates for the at-large member position, the eommy election offieer shall eall, and there shall be held, a primary election in sueh sehool distriet. The names of the two (2) eandidates reeciving the greatest number of votes for any member position at the primary election shall appear on the ballots in the general election. (b) In sehool distriets having the election at large method, if there are more than two (2) times the ntmber of eandidates as there are board members to be elected, the county election offieer shall call, and there shall be held, a primary election. The names of twiee the number of eandidates as there are board members to be elected who reeeived the greatest number of votes at the primary election shall appear on the batlots in the general election. (e) If a member is to be elected to fill an unexpired term the rules in this seetion shall be modified eonsistent with the provisions of this subsection. If there are more than two (2) eandidates for steh unexpired term, the eounty election offieer shall eall and there shall be held, a primary eleetion. The names of the two (2) eandidates for sueh unexpired term reeeiving the greatest number of votes shall appear on the ballots in the general election. (d) No ballot in a primary sehool election shall have either names or write-in blanks for any board member pesition unless more than two (2) eandidates have filed for sueh pesition.


(a) A primary election shall be held if needed to reduce the
number of candidates for each office in the general election to no more than three candidates. No primary election of school district board members shall be held unless by holding such primary two or more persons will be eliminated as candidates for office. In the event there are not more than three times the number of candidates as there are board members to be elected, the names of the candidates for such office shall not appear on the primary election ballots, and there shall be no primary election for such office, but the names of such candidates shall be placed on the general school board election ballot.
(e) (b) On the ballots in general school elections, blank lines for the name of write-in candidates shall be printed at the end of the list of candidates for each different office equal to the number to be elected thereto. The purpose of such blank lines shall be to permit the voter to insert the name of any person not printed on the ballot for whom such voter desires to vote for such office. No lines for write-in candidates shall appear on primary school election ballots.

Sec. 2. K.S.A. 25-2108a is hereby amended to read as follows: 252108a. (a) There shall be a primary election of city officers on the Tuesday preceding by five weeks the first Tuesday in April of every year that such city has a city election, except as otherwise provided in subsection (b) of this section.
(b) A primary election shall be held if needed to reduce the number of candidates for each office in the general election to no more than three candidates. No primary election of city officers shall be held unless by holding such primary me (1) two or more persons will be eliminated as candidates for office. In the event there are not more than (2) three times the number of candidates for any one offiee as there are officers to be elected, the names of the candidates for such office shall not appear on the primary election ballots, and there shall be no primary election for such office, but the names of such candidates shall be placed on the general city election ballot.

Sec. 3. K.S.A. 71-1415 is hereby amended to read as follows: 711415. (a) In any eollege distriet having a distriet method and in whieh there are more than two eandidates for a member position, the election effieer shall eall, and there shall be held, a primary election. The names of the two candidates receiving the greatest number of votes for any member position shall appear on the ballots in the general election.
(b) In any college distriet having the election-at-large method and in which there are more than two times the ntmber of eandidates as there are trustees to be elected, the election offieer shall eall, and there shatl be held, a primary eleetion. The names of twiee the ntmber of eandidates as there are trustees to be elected who receive the greatest number of wotes in the primary shall appear on the ballots in the general election.

(a) A primary election shall be held if needed to reduce the number of candidates for each office in the general election to no more than three candidates. No primary election of trustees shall be held unless by holding such primary two or more persons will be eliminated as candidates for office. In the event there are not more than three times the number of candidates as there are trustees to be elected, the names of the candidates for such office shall not appear on the primary election ballots, and there shall be no primary election for such office, but the names of such candidates shall be placed on the general election ballot for the board of trustees.
(e) (b) In the general election, there shall appear on the ballots a line appropriate for write-in candidates. No lines for write-in candidates shall appear on the primary election ballots.

Sec. 4. K.S.A. 25-2021, 25-2108a and 71-1415 are hereby repealed.
Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
