12AN ACT establishing the physician work force and accreditation task 13 force; providing for the composition and the duties and functions of 14the task force; report to the 2009 session of the legislature. 1516Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 17Section 1. (a) There is hereby established the physician workforce 18and accreditation task force, which is referred to in this section as the 19task force. The task force shall be composed of 12 members appointed 20as follows: (1) Two members who are members of the medical faculty or 21administrators of the school of medicine at of the university of Kansas 22medical center, of which one member shall be from the Kansas City 23 campus and one member shall be from the Wichita campus, who 24 shall be appointed by the dean of the school of medicine of the university 25of Kansas medical center; (2) two members who are practicing medicine 26in Kansas [and are current or former participants in a Kansas grad-27 **uate medical residency program**] who shall be appointed by the gov-28 ernor; (3) one member who shall be appointed by the state board of 29 regents; (4) one member who is representative of the Via Christi Regional 30 Medical Center who shall be appointed by the governing body of the 31 Wichita Center for Graduate Medical Education; (5) one member who 32 is representative of the Wesley Medical Center who shall be appointed 33 by the governing body of the Wichita Center for Graduate Medical Ed-34 ucation; (6) one member who shall be appointed by the Kansas health 35 policy authority; (7) [one member who is an administrator of a rural 36 hospital who shall be appointed by the Kansas hospital association; 37 (8)] one member who is a legislator who shall be appointed by the pres-38 ident of the senate; (8) [(9)] one member who is a legislator who shall be 39 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives; (9) [(10)] one 40 member who is a legislator who shall be appointed by the minority leader 41of the senate; and (10) [(11)] one member who is a legislator who shall 42be appointed by the minority leader of the house of representatives. 43 (b) The speaker of the house of representatives shall designate one 1 member to serve as chairperson of the task force and the president of the

2 senate shall designate one member to serve as the vice-chairperson of the 3 task force. The task force shall meet on call of the chairperson or on the 4 request of seven members of the task force, subject to approval by the 5 legislative coordinating council.

6 (c) Seven members of the task force shall constitute a quorum. All 7 actions of the task force shall be taken by a majority of all members of 8 the task force.

9 (d) The task force shall study and adopt recommendations regarding the physician work force and accreditation issues at the Wichita Center 10 for Graduate Medical Education, including: (1) How best to maintain 11 accreditation of the program while [graduate medical education pro-1213 grams sponsored by the university of Kansas school of medicine in 14Kansas City and Wichita, with special attention to] maintaining the 15 existing partnerships with Via Christi Regional Medical Center and[,] 16Wesley Medical Center [and the university of Kansas medical center 17- Wichita]; (2) recommendations for the necessary and appropriate level 18of funding for the program [graduate medical education sponsored 19by the university of Kansas]; (3) alternative means of obtaining such 20funding; and (4) a business [strategic] plan to accomplish such matters. 21(e) The task force shall report its findings and recommendations to the 22 committee on ways and means of the senate and the committee on ap-23 propriations of the house of representatives prior to the beginning of the 24 2009 regular session of the legislature. 25(f) The staff of the office of the revisor of statutes, the legislative re-26search department and the division of legislative administrative services

shall provide such assistance as may be requested by the task force and
authorized by the legislative coordinating council.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the Kansas register.
