9 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging Congress and the President 10 of the United States to develop a program of capturing and storing carbon and other greenhouse gases. 11 12 13 WHEREAS, Kansans are concerned about global air pollution and are taking steps to reduce contribution to such pollution; and 14 15 WHEREAS, Energy and health care costs may significantly increase because of growth in carbon dioxide emissions from all sources; and 16 WHEREAS, No state's actions can singularly nor significantly address 17 18 the risk to global air quality, energy costs and health care costs: Now, 19 therefore, 20 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas, the Senate concurring therein: That the President of the United States 21 22 and Congress are strongly urged to engage in meaningful discourse based 23 on sound science to develop a program of capturing and storing or sequestering carbon and other greenhouse gases, particulates and heavy 24 metals that cannot be productively used in other manufacturing proc-25 26 esses; and 27 Be it further resolved: That the President and Congress are urged to engage other nations in identifying cost-effective steps to reduce emis-28 29 sions on a global basis; and Be it further resolved: That the secretary of state is directed to send 30 31
