9 CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the Congress of the United А 10 States to pass legislation that provides for the forfeiture of tax credits, deductions and exemptions for employers that employ unauthorized 11 12aliens. 13 14WHEREAS, Recent government and academic estimates indicate that 15there are between 10 million and 13 million unauthorized aliens currently 16living in the United States; and 17WHEREAS, States have been left with the burden of providing so-18lutions for the myriad of problems arising from the presence of such large 19numbers of unauthorized aliens; and 20WHEREAS, States expend billions of dollars on the provision of 21health, education and social services to immigrants, including unauthor-22 ized aliens, as well as expenditures related to the many law enforcement 23 issues raised by the influx of unauthorized aliens; and WHEREAS, Many employers benefit from the utilization of immi-24 25grants, including unauthorized aliens, in their business operation through 26 inexpensive labor costs of employment of such individuals; and 27WHEREAS, Employers are allowed or granted over three billion dol-28lars in tax credits, deductions and exemptions under Kansas law, and 29 countless billions across all 50 states; and 30 WHEREAS, The connection between employers adhering to state and federal law with regard to the employment of unauthorized aliens and 3132 the privilege of benefiting from income tax credits and deductions and 33 sales, property and severance tax exemptions and exemptions from any 34 other tax imposed by law is entirely appropriate and the loss of these tax 35 advantages under circumstances in which employers have violated the law in this critical area would serve as a viable, effective and reasonable 36 37 solution to this problem: Now, therefore, 38 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas, 39 the Senate concurring therein: That we urge the Congress of the United States to pass legislation that provides for the forfeiture of tax credits, 40 deductions and exemptions for employers that employ unauthorized ali-4142ens: and
