9 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION concerning endorsement of the 10 participation of Taiwan in the World Health Organization. 11 12 WHEREAS, Good health is important to every citizen of the world 13 and access to the highest standards of health information and services is 14necessary to improve public health; and 15WHEREAS, Direct and unobstructed participation in international 16health cooperation forums and programs is beneficial for all parts of the world, especially with today's greater potential for the cross-border spread 1718of various infectious diseases; and 19WHEREAS, Taiwan's population of 23,000,000 people is larger than 20that of three-fourths of the member states already in the World Health 21Organization; and 22 WHEREAS, Taiwan's achievements in the field of health are substan-23 tial, including achieving one of the highest life-expectancy levels in Asia; lowering maternal and infant mortality rates to a level comparable to those 24 25of western countries; eradicating such infectious diseases as cholera, 26smallpox, the plague and polio; and providing hepatitis B vaccinations to 27 children; and 28WHEREAS, The United States Centers for Disease Control and Pre-29 vention and its Taiwan counterpart agencies have enjoyed close collabo-30 ration on a wide range of public health issues; and 31WHEREAS, In recent years, Taiwan has expressed a willingness to 32 assist financially and technically in international aid and health activities supported by the World Health Organization; and 33 34 WHEREAS, The United States, in the 1994 Taiwan Policy Review, 35 declared its intention to support Taiwan's participation in appropriate 36 international organizations: Now, therefore, 37 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas, 38 the Senate concurring therein: That the Legislature endorses Taiwan's 39 participation in the World Health Organization; and 40 Be it further resolved: That the Secretary of State is directed to send enrolled copies of this resolution to the President of the United States, 4142the Secretary of State of the United States, the United States Secretary
