AN ACT amending Alexa's law; amending K.S.A. 21-3452 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 21-3452 is hereby amended to read as follows: 21-3452. (a) This section shall be known and may be cited as Alexa's law.

- (b) As used in this section:(1) "Abortion" means an abortion as defined by K.S.A. 65-6701, and
- amendments thereto.

 (2) "Unborn child" means a living individual organism of the species homo sapiens, in utero, at any stage of gestation from fertilization to birth.
 - (c) This section shall not apply to:
 - (1) Any *lawful* act committed by the mother of the unborn child;
 - (2) any medical procedure, including abortion, performed by a physician or other licensed medical professional at the request of the pregnant woman or her legal guardian; or
- 25 (3) the lawful dispensation or administration of lawfully prescribed medication.
- 27 (d) As used in K.S.A. 21-3401, 21-3402, 21-3403, 21-3404, 21-3405, 21-3412, 21-3414, 21-3439 and 21-3442, and amendments thereto, "person" and "human being" also mean an unborn child.
- 30 (e) The provisions of this act shall be part of and supplemental to the 31 Kansas criminal code.
- 32 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 21-3452 is hereby repealed.
- 33 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
