Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Every treasurer for a party committee or political committee shall file reports of independent expenditures as prescribed by this act. Reports shall be filed with the secretary of state. Reports required by this section shall be in additions to any other reports required by law.

- (b) The report shall contain the name and address of each party committee or political committee which has made or contracted to be made independent expenditures in an aggregate amount or value in excess of \$300 or more during the period commencing 11 days before a primary or general election at which a state or local officer is to be elected and ending before the day of such election. Such report shall contain the amount, date and purpose of each such independent expenditure as well as the name of the candidate for whom the independent expenditure expressly advocates the election or defeat of. When an independent expenditure is made by payment to an advertising agency, public relations firm or political consultant for disbursement to vendors, the report of such independent expenditure shall show in detail the name of each such vendor and the amount, date and purpose of the payments to each as well as the name of the candidate for whom the independent expenditure expressly advocates the election or defeat of. The report shall be made on or before the close of the next business day in which any independent expenditure is made.
- (c) Reports required by this section shall be filed by hand delivery, express delivery service, facsimile transmission or any electronic method authorized by the secretary of state.
- (d) (1) "Expenditure" shall have the meaning ascribed to it in K.S.A. 25-4143 and amendments thereto.
- (2) "Independent expenditure" means an expenditure that is not controlled by or coordinated with any candidate or agent of such candidate.
- (3) "Party committee" shall have the meaning ascribed to it in K.S.A. 25-4143 and amendments thereto.
- (4) "Political committee" shall have the meaning ascribed to it in
