9 AN ACT relating to marriage; designating new surname; amending 10 K.S.A. 23-133 and repealing the existing section. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 23-133 is hereby amended to read as follows: 23-14133. (a) At the time of marriage, a person may designate a new legal name 15surname, by which such person shall subsequently be known. Such name 16 may include a combination of the person's prior existing name and the 17prior existing name of such person's spouse, or derivative versions thereof 18surname shall be the spouse's current surname or a combination of the 19person's current surname and the spouse's current surname. 20(b) A person's name, as designated pursuant to subsection (a), shall 21be recorded on the marriage license issued to such person, along with 22 such person's name at the time of the person's application for such li-23 cense, which shall be described thereon as the person's former name. 24 (c) The change to the person's new legal name surname shall be ef-25fective upon the endorsement of the person's marriage license with the 26 certificate of marriage of the person who performed the marriage cere-27 mony pursuant to K.S.A. 23-109, and amendments thereto. 28(d) - A certified copy of a person's marriage license endorsed with a 29 eertificate of marriage pursuant to K.S.A. 23-109, and amendments thereto, shall constitute proof of identity for the purposes of issuance of 30 31any Kansas driver's license or nondriver's identification card. 32 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 23-133 is hereby repealed. 33 This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its Sec. 3. 34 publication in the statute book.
