K.S.A. 72-3603 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-163603. As used in this act: "Board" means the board of education of any school district. 17(a) 18"School district" means any public school district organized and (b)19operating under the laws of this state. 20(c) "Parent education program" means a program developed and op-21erated by a board for the purpose of providing expectant parents and 22parents of infants or toddlers or both with information, advice, assistance, 23 resource materials, guidance and learning experiences regarding such 24 measures as parenting skills and the various styles of parenting, the proc-25esses and principles of growth and development of children, home learn-26ing activities designed for infants and toddlers, techniques emphasizing a 27 positive approach to discipline, effective methods of communicating and 28interacting with children so as to foster the development of self-esteem, 29 strategies for structuring behavioral limits and increasing mutual positive 30 regard, and other elements of effective parenting that are conducive to 31 the structuring of a home environment in which children are encouraged 32 to be successful and productive learners. 33 "Infant" and "toddler" mean a child who has not attained the age 34 of three years means any child under the age of eligibility for school 35 attendance. 36 "State board" means the state board of education.
