AN ACT concerning campaign finance; prohibiting the use of public 1011 funds and certain other public assets to influence the nomination or 12 election of a candidate; amending K.S.A. 25-4169a and repealing the 13 existing section. 1415Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 16Section 1. K.S.A. 25-4169a is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-4169a. (a) (1) No officer or employee of the state of Kansas, or any <del>county,</del> 1718any unified school district having 35,000 or more pupils regularly enrolled, any city of the first class or the board of public utilities of the city 1920of Kansas City, Kansas municipality, shall use or authorize the use of 21public funds or public vehicles, machinery, equipment or supplies of any 22such governmental agency or the time of any officer or employee of any 23 such governmental agency, for which the officer or employee is compensated by such governmental agency, to expressly advocate the nomination, 24 25election or defeat of a clearly identified candidate to state office or local 26office. The provisions of this section prohibiting the use of time of any 27 officer or employee for such purposes shall not apply to an incumbent officer campaigning for nomination or reelection to a succeeding term to 2829 such office or to members of the personal staff of any elected officer. 30 Except as otherwise provided in this section, no municipality (2)31shall permit or allow any person to distribute, or cause to be dis-32 tributed, within any building or other structure owned, leased or 33 rented by such municipality any brochure, flier, political fact sheet 34 or other document which expressly advocates the nomination, elec-35 tion or defeat of a clearly identified candidate for state or local office unless each candidate for such state or local office is permit-36 37 ted or allowed to do so in the same manner. 38 (2) (3) For the purposes of this subsection, the term municipality shall 39 have the meaning ascribed to it in K.S.A. 12-105b 12-105a and amend-40 ments thereto. 41(b) Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty 42of a class C misdemeanor. 43 Sec. 2.
