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23	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
24	[Section 1. K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 74-616 is hereby amended to
25	read as follows: 74-616. In addition to other powers and duties
26	provided by law, in administering the provisions of this act the
27	state corporation commission shall:
28	[(a) Adopt rules and regulations necessary for the administra-
29	tion of this act;
30	[(b) develop a comprehensive state energy conservation plan
31	and the procedures for implementing the plan according to federal
32	requirements;
33	[(c) allow, at the option of the requesting utility, the capitalization
34	and addition to rate base of investments in and expenditures for commis-
35	sion approved energy efficiency, conservation and demand management
36	programs;
37	[(d)] make requests for and accept funds and other assistance
38	from federal agencies for energy conservation and other energy-
39	related activities in this state, including, but not limited to, the
40	state energy program;
41	[(d) (e) administer federal energy conservation programs in
42	this state; and
43	[(e)(f)] prepare an emergency management plan for natural gas

[2.] K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 74-8959 is hereby amended to read 8 as follows: 74-8959. (a) (1) There is hereby established in the state treas-9 ury the state housing trust fund. All moneys credited to the state housing 10 trust fund shall be used for the purposes of housing programs and services including, but not limited to, the provision of financial programs for the 11 12repair, rehabilitation and improvement of existing residential housing, 13 accessibility modifications, rental subsidies, the provision of housing serv-14ices and assistance to persons having low or moderate income and disa-15bled persons and costs and expenditures incurred in implementing K.S.A. 1658-4217 through 58-4224, and amendments thereto, of the Kansas man-17ufactured housing act. 18(2) (A) There is hereby created the weatherization assistance program 19account within the state housing trust fund. All moneys credited to the 20weatherization assistance program account shall be used to fund grants 21under the weatherization assistance program to increase housing energy 22efficiency. On July 1, 2008, and each July 1 thereafter, the director of

23 accounts and reports shall transfer \$2,000,000 from the state general fund 24 to the weatherization assistance program account of the state housing 25 trust fund. Subject to the provisions of federal law, for the fiscal year

25 trust fund. Subject to the provisions of federal law, for the fiscal year 26 ending June 30, 2009, and each ensuing fiscal year, the head of the

agency receiving the low income energy assistance block grant shall
 transfer <u>15%</u> 25% of any <u>emergency or supplemental</u> federal ap-

propriations for such block grant to the weatherization assistance
 program account.

(B) Persons eligible to receive assistance from the weatheri zation assistance program must be current in their utility bills, or
 current in a commission approved payment schedule.

34 The head of the agency administering the weatherization (3)35 assistance program shall submit an annual accountability report to 36 the senate committee on utilities and the house committee on en-37 ergy and utilities, or their successors, on or before the first day of 38 the 2009 regular session of the legislature, and on or before the 39 first day of each ensuing regular session of the legislature through 40 2011. The report shall include, but not be limited to, the following: 41The number of homes weatherized by each sub-grantee of (A)

42 the weatherization assistance program, and whether those homes

43 were owner-occupied or rental properties;

1 (B) whether actual utility usage was factored into the scoring 2 that determined whether to grant assistance;

3 (C) whether each county in the state has a waiting list for the
4 weatherization assistance program, and the number on those wait5 ing lists; and

6 (D) the progress each sub-grantee has made in working with 7 local utilities to identify applicants' homes with the highest usage, 8 using the customer billing information waiver in the application 9 for assistance.

10 (b) The state housing trust fund shall be administered by the division 11 of housing in the Kansas development finance authority.

(c) The division of housing and the Kansas development finance authority are hereby authorized to apply for and receive available public or
private grants, gifts and donations for the purposes of housing programs
and services. All such grants, gifts and donations shall be remitted to the
division of housing in the Kansas development finance authority.

(d) On or before the 10th of each month, the director of accounts
and reports shall transfer from the state general fund to the state housing
trust fund interest earnings based on:

20 (1) The average daily balance of moneys in the state housing trust 21 fund for the preceding month; and

(2) the net earnings rate for the pooled money investment portfoliofor the preceding month.
