9 AN ACT concerning certain county contracts; relating to bidding 10 requirements; amending K.S.A. 19-214 and repealing the existing section. 11 12 13Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 19-214 is hereby amended to read as follows: 19-15 214. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) and in K.S.A. 19-216a, all 16 contracts for the expenditure of county moneys for the construction of 17any courthouse, jail or other county building, or the construction of any 18bridge in excess of \$10,000 the amount specified in subsection (c), shall 19be awarded, on a public letting, to the lowest and best bid. The person, 20firm or corporation to whom the contract may be awarded shall give and 21file with the board of county commissioners a good and sufficient surety 22 bond by a surety company authorized to do business in the state of Kansas, 23 to be approved by the county attorney or county counselor, in the amount 24 of the contract, and conditioned for the faithful performance of the 25contract. 26(b) The provisions of subsection (a) shall not apply: (1) To the ex-27 penditure of county funds for professional services; (2) to the provisions 28of K.S.A. 68-521, and amendments thereto; or (3) to the purchase of 29 contracts of insurance. 30 The minimum amount of county moneys for which contracts shall (c)31be awarded as required in subsection (a) shall be determined as follows: 32 For the fiscal year ending on December 31, 2008, the minimum (1)33 amount shall be \$25,000. 34 (2) For each subsequent fiscal year after 2008, the amount shall be 35 determined by the county commission on or before January 1 of such 36 fiscal year and shall be equal to the minimum amount for the preceding 37 fiscal year plus an additional amount determined by the county commis-38 sion to be proportionally equal to the increase, if any, by which the con-39 sumer price index for all urban consumers published by the United States 40 department of labor for the preceding calendar year, exceeds that index 41for the second preceding calendar year. 42Sec. 2. K.S.A. 19-214 is hereby repealed.
