12 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years ending 13 June 30, 2009, and June 30, 2010, for state agencies; authorizing certain transfers, capital improvement projects and fees, imposing certain restrictions and limitations, and directing or authorizing certain receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing. Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: Section 1. (a) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2009, and June 30, 2010, appropriations are hereby made, restrictions and limitations are hereby imposed, and transfers, capital improvement projects, fees, receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing are hereby directed or authorized as provided in this act. (b) The agencies named in this act are hereby authorized to initiate and complete the capital improvement projects specified and authorized by this act or for which appropriations are made by this act, subject to the restrictions and limitations imposed by this act. (c) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of K.S.A. 75-6702 and amendments thereto. (d) The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 46-155 and amendments thereto. Sec. 2. (y) (x) In addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be made by the above agency from the department of wildlife and parks gifts and donations fund for fiscal year 2009, expenditures may be made by the above agency from the department of wildlife and parks gifts and donations fund for fiscal year 2009 from the unencumbered balance as of June 30, 2008, in each existing capital improvement account of the department of wildlife and parks gifts and donations fund: Provided, That expenditures from the unencumbered balance of any such existing capital improvement account shall not exceed the amount of the unencumbered balance in such account on June 30, 2008: Provided further, That all expenditures from the unencumbered balance of any such account shall be in addition to any expenditure limitation imposed on the department of wildlife and parks gifts and donations fund for fiscal year 2009 and shall be in addition to any other expenditure limitation imposed on any such account of the department of wildlife and parks gifts and donations fund for fiscal year 2009.

(y) In addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be made by the above agency from the department road access fund for fiscal year 2009, expenditures shall be made by the above agency from the following capital improvement account or accounts of the department road access fund during fiscal year 2009 for the following capital improvement project or projects, subject to the expenditure limitations prescribed therefor:

(z) In addition to the other purposes for which expenditures may be made by the above agency from the wildlife fee fund for fiscal year 2009, expenditures may be made by the above agency from the following capital improvement account or accounts of the wildlife fee fund during fiscal year 2009 for the following capital improvement project or projects, subject to the expenditure limitations prescribed therefor:

43 Sec. 28. Appeals to exceed expenditure limitations. (a) Upon written

application to the governor and approval of the state finance council, expenditures from special revenue funds may exceed the amounts specified in this act.

(b) This section shall not apply to the expanded lottery act revenues fund, state economic development initiatives fund, the children's initiatives fund, the state water plan fund or the Kansas endowment for youth fund, or to any account of any of such funds.

Sec. 29. Savings. (a) Any unencumbered balance as of June 30, 2008, in any special revenue fund, or account thereof, of any state agency named in this act which is not otherwise specifically appropriated or limited by this or other appropriation act of the 2008 regular session of the legislature, is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, for the same use and purpose as the same was heretofore appropriated.

(b) This section shall not apply to the expanded lottery act revenues fund, state economic development initiatives fund, the children's initiatives fund, the state water plan fund, the Kansas endowment for youth fund, the Kansas educational building fund, the state institutions building fund, or the correctional institutions building fund, or to any account of any of such funds.

Sec. 30. During the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, all moneys which are lawfully credited to and available in any bond special revenue fund, which are not otherwise specifically appropriated or limited by this or other appropriation act of the 2008 regular session of the legislature, are hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, for the state agency for which the bond special revenue fund was established for the purposes authorized by law for expenditures from such bond special revenue fund. As used in this section, "bond special revenue fund" means any special revenue fund or account thereof established in the state treasury prior to or on or after the effective date of this act for the deposit of the proceeds of bonds issued by the Kansas development finance authority, for the payment of debt service for bonds issued by the Kansas development finance authority, or for any related purpose in accordance with applicable bond covenants.

Sec. 31. (a) Any correctional institutions building fund appropriation heretofore appropriated to any state agency named in this or other appropriation act of the 2008 regular session of the legislature, and having an unencumbered balance as of June 30, 2008, in excess of \$100 is hereby reappropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, for the same uses and purposes as originally appropriated unless specific provision is made for lapsing such appropriation.

(b) This section shall not apply to the unencumbered balance in any account of the correctional institutions building fund that was first appropriated for any fiscal year commencing prior to July 1, 2007.

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Sec. 32. (a) Any Kansas educational building fund appropriation heretofore appropriated to any institution named in this or other appropriation act of the 2008 regular session of the legislature and having an unencumbered balance as of June 30, 2008, in excess of \$100 is hereby reappropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, for the same use and purpose as originally appropriated, unless specific provision is made for lapsing such appropriation.

(b) This section shall not apply to the unencumbered balance in any account of the Kansas educational building fund that was first appropriated for any fiscal year commencing prior to July 1, 2007.

Sec. 33. (a) Any state institutions building fund appropriation heretofore appropriated to any state agency named in this or other appropriation act of the 2008 regular session of the legislature and having an unencumbered balance as of June 30, 2008, in excess of \$100 is hereby reappropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009, for the same use and purpose as originally appropriated, unless specific provision is made for lapsing such appropriation.

(b) This section shall not apply to the unencumbered balance in any account of the state institutions building fund that was first appropriated for any fiscal year commencing prior to July 1, 2007.

Sec. 34. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
