10 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal years ending  
11 June 30, 2008, June 30, 2009, June 30, 2010, and June 30, 2011, for  
12 state agencies; authorizing certain transfers, capital improvement pro-  
13 jects and fees, imposing certain restrictions and limitations, and di-  
14 recting or authorizing certain receipts, disbursements and acts inci-  
15 dental to the foregoing.

17 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

Section 1. (a) For the fiscal years ending June 30, 2008, June 30, 2009,  
19 June 30, 2010, and June 30, 2011, appropriations are hereby made, re-  
20 strictions and limitations are hereby imposed, and transfers, capital im-  
21 provement projects, fees, receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to  
22 the foregoing are hereby directed or authorized as provided in this act.

23

(b) The agencies named in this act are hereby authorized to initiate  
24 and complete the capital improvement projects specified and authorized  
25 by this act or for which appropriations are made by this act, subject to  
26 the restrictions and limitations imposed by this act.

(c) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of  
28 K.S.A. 75-6702, and amendments thereto.

(d) The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to the  
30 provisions of K.S.A. 46-155, and amendments thereto.
