10 AN ACT making and concerning appropriations for the fiscal year [years]
11 ending June 30, 2009, [June 30, 2010, June 30, 2011, June 30,
12 2012, June 30, 2013, June 30, 2014, and June 30, 2015,] for the
13 state board of regents; authorizing certain transfers, capital improve-
14 ment projects and fees, imposing certain restrictions and limitations,
15 and directing or authorizing certain receipts, disbursements and acts
16 incidental to the foregoing.

18 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

19 Section 1. (a) For the fiscal year [years] ending June 30, 2009, [June
20 30, 2010, June 30, 2011, June 30, 2012, June 30, 2013, June 30,
21 2014, and June 30, 2015,] appropriations are hereby made, restrictions
22 and limitations are hereby imposed, and transfers, capital improvement
23 projects, fees, receipts, disbursements and acts incidental to the foregoing
24 are hereby directed or authorized as provided in this act.

25 (b) This act shall not be subject to the provisions of subsection (a) of
26 K.S.A. 75-6702 and amendments thereto.

27 (c) The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to the
28 provisions of K.S.A. 46-155 and amendments thereto.

31 (a) There is appropriated for the above agency from the state general
32 fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 [year or years specified],
33 the following:

34 Kansas academy for math and science \$295,000
35 Postsecondary education operating grant \$20,083,836

36 [Postsecondary education operating grant
37 [For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2009 \$20,083,836]

38 Provided, That the state board of regents is hereby authorized to transfer
39 moneys from the postsecondary education operating grant account to the
40 appropriate account or accounts of the state general fund of any state
41 educational institution under the control and supervision of the state
42 board of regents: Provided further, That the state board of regents shall
43 certify to the director of accounts and reports each such transfer of mon-

1 eys from the postsecondary education operating grant account: *And pro-*
 2 *vided further*, That the state board of regents shall transmit a copy of
 3 each such certification to the director of the budget and to the director
 4 of legislative research.

 14 ***is hereby reappropriated for fiscal year 2011.***
 15 **[For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2012 \$792,000**
 16 ***[Provided, That any unencumbered balance in the Kansas academy***
 17 ***for math and science account in excess of \$100 as of June 30, 2011,***
 18 ***is hereby reappropriated for fiscal year 2012.***
 19 **[For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013 \$835,000**
 20 ***[Provided, That any unencumbered balance in the Kansas academy***
 21 ***for math and science account in excess of \$100 as of June 30, 2012,***
 22 ***is hereby reappropriated for fiscal year 2013.***
 23 **[For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2014 \$938,000**
 24 ***[Provided, That any unencumbered balance in the Kansas academy***
 25 ***for math and science account in excess of \$100 as of June 30, 2013,***
 26 ***is hereby reappropriated for fiscal year 2014.***
 27 ***[Any unencumbered balance in the Kansas academy for math and***
 28 ***science account in excess of \$100 as of June 30, 2014, is hereby***
 29 ***reappropriated for fiscal year 2015.]***
