12 AN ACT concerning cities; relating to the use of credit cards by persons
13 to pay certain taxes, fees and exactions.

15 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

16 Section 1. ~~Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 16a-2-403, and~~
17 ~~amendments thereto, A~~ any city may accept credit **or debit** cards for the
18 payment of taxes, utility fees or other exactions. ~~Any~~ **The** city may estab-
19 lish the type of credit **or debit** card the city will accept ~~and~~. **The city**
20 may set a fee to be added to each credit card transaction equal to the
21 charge paid by the city for the use of the credit card by the person. **If**
22 **the city imposes a fee for payments made by credit card, the city**
23 **shall provide notice of such fee to the person making payment by**
24 **credit card.**

25 **Any transaction involving payment by credit card pursuant to**
26 **this section shall not be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 16a-2-**
27 **403, and amendments thereto.**

28 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
29 publication in the statute book.
