16 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 16a-2-403, and amendments thereto, A any city may accept credit or debit cards for the 1718payment of taxes, utility fees or other exactions. Any The city may establish the type of credit or debit card the city will accept and. The city 1920may set a fee to be added to each credit card transaction equal to the 21charge paid by the city for the use of the credit card by the person. If 22 the city imposes a fee for payments made by credit card, the city 23 shall provide notice of such fee to the person making payment by 24 credit card. 25Any transaction involving payment by credit card pursuant to 26 this section shall not be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 16a-2-27 403, and amendments thereto.
