9 AN ACT concerning colleges and universities; relating to textbooks.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The chief executive officer of each postsecondary educational institution shall implement policies, procedures and guidelines that require the publishers of textbooks to provide:

- (1) With any marketing materials presented to a member of the faculty or staff, the retail price at which the publisher would make the text-books available to the institution and the history of revisions for the text-books, if any; and
- (2) to the institution, the retail price of textbooks required or recommended by faculty or staff for a given course and the date and retail price of the last edition of such textbook 90 days prior to the date of the beginning of such course.
- (b) The guidelines shall ensure that faculty and staff consider the least costly practices in assigning textbooks when educational content is comparable as determined by the faculty or staff. Such price information shall be made available to students at the time of enrollment in such course and shall be posted on the institution's website.
- (c) As used in this section "postsecondary educational institution" shall have the meaning ascribed thereto by K.S.A. 74-3201b, and amendments thereto.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
