9 AN ACT concerning the Kansas lottery; relating to the veterans benefit 10 game; amending K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 74-8724 and repealing the existing 11 section. 12 13Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 14Section 1. K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 74-8724 is hereby amended to read as 15follows: 74-8724. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, 16the Kansas lottery commission shall establish an instant lottery scratch-17off game designated as the veterans benefit game, which shall be conducted by the Kansas lottery. Tickets for the veterans benefit game es-1819tablished by this section shall be offered for sale only between May 1 20through November 30 of each year year-round. 21The Kansas lottery commission shall adopt rules and regulations (b) 22 governing the establishment of the veterans benefit game pursuant to 23 K.S.A. 74-8710, and amendments thereto, except that subsection (b) of 24 K.S.A. 74-8710, and amendments thereto, shall not apply to the veterans 25benefit game established by this section. 26Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 79-4801 et seq., and (c) 27K.S.A. 74-8711, and amendments thereto, all net profits, received from 28the sale of veterans benefit game lottery tickets, materials and games, as 29 prescribed by rules and regulations adopted pursuant to subsection (b) 30 of this section, shall be deposited in the state treasury and shall be used 31as follows: (1) The amount equal to From July 1, 2008, to June 30, 2010, 32 an amount equal to 40% of such net profits and thereafter, an amount 33 equal to 50% of such net profits shall be appropriated for purposes di-34 rectly benefitting members of the Kansas army and air national guard and their families to provide for Kansas national guard educational assistance 35 36 act scholarships pursuant to K.S.A. 74-32,145 et seq., and amendments 37 thereto, and, to the extent that moneys are available, for other purposes 38 directly benefitting members of the Kansas army and air national guard 39 and their families as provided by appropriation act; and (2) the amount 40 equal to From July 1, 2008, to June 30, 2010, an amount equal to 30% of 41such net profits and thereafter, an amount equal to 50% of such net profits 42shall be appropriated for operating expenditures and capital improve-43 ments, or as otherwise provided by appropriation act, for the use and

benefit of the Kansas veterans' home, the Kansas soldiers' home and the
 state veterans cemetery system; and

3 (3) an amount equal to 30% of such net profits from July 1, 2008, to
4 June 30, 2010, shall be appropriated for the museum of the Kansas na5 tional guard to expand the museum facility to include a 35th Infantry
6 Division Museum and a museum education center.

7 (d) The Kansas lottery commission shall change the design or theme 8 of the veterans benefit game regularly so that the game remains com-9 petitive with the other instant lottery scratch-off games offered by such 10 commission. The tickets for the instant lottery game authorized by this 11 section shall clearly state that the profits derived from the game shall be 12 used to benefit veterans and veterans issues in this state.

13 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2007 Supp. 74-8724 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after itspublication in the Kansas register.
