Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 45-229, and amendments thereto, open record exceptions contained in the following statutes as certified by the revisor of statutes to the president of the senate and the speaker of the house of representatives pursuant to subsection (e) of K.S.A. 45-229, and amendments thereto, during 2006 and 2007 are hereby continued in existence until July 15, 2009, in order for the legislature to review the open records exceptions of such statutes as provided in K.S.A. 45-229, and amendments thereto, at which time such exceptions shall expire: 8-240, 8-247, 8-1324, 8-1325, 12-17,150, 12-2001, 40-5006, 40-5108, 41-2905, 41-2906, 44-706, 44-1518, 65-3239 and 66-1233.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
