Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 72-5437 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-5437. (a) Subject to the provisions of subsection (c), all contracts of employment of teachers, as defined in K.S.A. 72-5436, and amendments thereto, except contracts entered into under the provisions of K.S.A. 72-5412a, and amendments thereto, shall be deemed to continue for the next succeeding school year unless written notice of termination or nonrenewal is served as provided in this subsection. Written notice to terminate a contract may be served by a board upon any teacher prior to the time the contract has been completed, and written notice of intention to nonrenew a contract shall be served by a board upon any teacher on or before May 1. A teacher shall give written notice to a board that the teacher does not desire continuation of a contract on or before May 15 or, if applicable, not later than 15 days after final action is taken by the board upon termination of professional negotiation absent a binding agreement under article 54 of chapter 72 of Kansas Statutes Annotated, whichever is the later date.

- (b) Terms of a contract may be changed at any time by mutual consent of both a teacher and a board.
- (c) The provisions of this subsection shall apply whenever a bill containing the appropriation from the state general fund for general state aid for the ensuing school year has not been approved by the governor on or before April 16. Written notice to terminate a contract may be served by a board upon any teacher prior to the time the contract has been completed. Written notice of intention to non-renew a contract shall be served by a board upon any teacher not later than 15 days after the date on which the bill containing the appropriation from the state general fund for state general aid is approved by the governor. A teacher shall give written notice to a board that the teacher does not desire continuation of a contract (1) not later than 30 days after the date on which the bill containing the appropriation from the state general fund for state general

aid is approved by the governor or (2) if applicable, not later than 15 days after final action is taken by the board upon termination of profes-3 sional negotiation absent a binding agreement under article 54 of chapter 72 of Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, whichever is 4 the later date.

- (e) (d) As used in this section, "teacher" means (1) a teacher as defined by K.S.A. 72-5436, and amendments thereto, and (2) any professional employee who is a retirant from school employment of the Kansas public employees retirement system.
- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 72-5452 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-5452. (a) Subject to the provisions of subsection (c), written notice of a board's intention to not renew the contract of employment of an administrator shall be given to the administrator on or before May 1 of the year in which the term of the administrator's contract expires. An administrator shall give written notice to a board on or before May 15 of the administrator's rejection of renewal of a contract of employment.
- (b) Terms of a contract may be changed at any time by mutual consent of both an administrator and a board.
- The provisions of this subsection shall apply whenever a bill containing the appropriation from the state general fund for general state aid for the ensuing school year has not been approved by the governor on or before April 16. Written notice to terminate a contract may be served by a board upon any administrator prior to the time the contract has been completed. Written notice of intention to non-renew a contract shall be served by a board upon any administrator not later than 15 days after the date on which the bill containing the appropriation from the state general fund for state general aid is approved by the governor. An administrator shall give written notice to a board that the administrator does not desire continuation of a contract (1) not later than 30 days after the date on which the bill containing the appropriation from the state general fund for state general aid is approved by the governor or (2) not later than 15 days after final action is taken by the board upon termination of professional negotiation absent a binding agreement under article 54 of chapter 72 of Kansas Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, whichever is the later date.
- Sec. 3. K.S.A. 72-5452 and K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 72-5437 are hereby 36 37 repealed.
