(a) On and after January 1, 2010, all state agencies, de-13 partments, boards and commissions, counties or any municipality, as de-14fined in K.S.A. 75-1117, and amendments thereto, who is an employer 15shall enroll and actively participate in e-verify for verification of employ-16ment status of all employees whose employment commences after Jan-17uary 1, 2010. 18(b) On and after January 1, 2010, no state agency, department, board, 19commission, county or municipality, as defined in K.S.A. 75-1117, and amendments thereto, shall award a public works or purchase contract to 2021a bidder, contractor or employer, nor shall a bidder, contractor or em-22 ployer be eligible to bid for or receive a public works contract if such 23 bidder, contractor or employer does not verify the employment eligibility 24 of the employees of such bidder, contractor or employer through e-verify. 25A bidder, contractor or employer shall be responsible for ensuring that 26any subcontractor, which such bidder, contractor or employer contracts 27with for a public works or purchase contract, verifies the employment 28eligibility of the employees of such subcontractor through e-verify. 29 (c) Nothing in this section shall be construed to require a bidder, 30 contractor or employer to take any action that the bidder, contractor or 31 employer believes in good faith would violate federal or state law. 32 (d) As used in this section unless the context otherwise requires: 33 (1)"E-verify" means an electronic system as jointly administered by 34 the United States department of homeland security and the social security 35 administration or its successor program, pursuant to 8 U.S.C. 1324a, which is used to verify the employment authorization of employees. 36 37 (2)"Employee" means any person who performs employment serv-38 ices for an employer pursuant to an employment relationship between 39 the employee and employer. 40 "Employer" means any individual or type of organization that (3)41transacts business in this state and that employs one or more individuals 42who perform employment services in this state. 43
