9 AN ACT enacting the national school psychologist certification incentive 10program. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. (a) As used in this section, "school district" means any 14school district, school district interlocal cooperative, school district co-15operative or nonpublic school accredited by the state board of education. 16The national school psychologist certification incentive program (b) 17is hereby established for the purpose of rewarding school psychologists 18who have attained certification from the national association of school 19psychologists. School psychologists who have attained certification from 20the national association and who are employed by a school district shall 21be paid an incentive bonus in the amount of \$1,000 each school year that 22 the school psychologist remains employed by a school district and retains 23 a valid certification from the national association of school psychologists. 24 Each school district employing one or more national association (c) 25certified school psychologists shall pay the incentive bonus to each such 26 school psychologist in each school year that the school psychologist retains 27eligibility for such payment. Each board of education which has made 28payments of incentive bonuses to national association certified school psy-29 chologists under this subsection may file an application with the state 30 board of education for state aid and shall certify to the state board the 31amount of such payments. The application and certification shall be on a 32 form prescribed and furnished by the state board, shall contain such in-33 formation as the state board shall require and shall be filed at the time 34 specified by the state board. 35 In each school year, each school district employing one or more (d) 36 national association certified school psychologists is entitled to receive 37 from state appropriations for the national school psychology certification 38 incentive program an amount which is equal to the amount certified to 39 the state board of education in accordance with the provisions of subsec-40 tion (c). The state board shall certify to the director of accounts and reports the amount due each school district. The director of accounts and 4142reports shall draw warrants on the state treasurer payable to the treasurer 43 of each school district entitled to payment under this section upon vouch1 ers approved by the state board.

2 (e) Moneys received by a board of education under this section shall

3 be deposited in the general fund of the school district and shall be con-

4 sidered reimbursements to the district for the purpose of the school dis-

5 trict finance and quality performance act and may be expended whether

6 the same have been budgeted or not.

7 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 8 publication in the statute book.
