Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, in addition to any other fee prescribed by law, the secretary of wildlife and parks shall fix, charge and collect a \$5 conservation fee on each license, permit, tag and other issue of the department of wildlife and parks purchased by persons who are not Kansas residents. The secretary of wildlife and parks shall remit all moneys received by or for it for the conservation fee prescribed by this section to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury, to the credit of the state water plan fund.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
