4	lawful purpose; but standing armies, in time of peace, are dangerous
5	to liberty, and shall not be tolerated, and the military shall be in
6	strict subordination to the civil power."
7	Sec. 2. The following statement shall be printed on the ballot with
8	the amendment as a whole:
9	"Explanatory statement. The purpose of this amendment is to pre-
0	serve constitutionally the right of a person to keep and bear arms
1	for the defense of self, family, home and state, and for all other
2	lawful purposes, including hunting and recreation.
3 4	"A vote for this amendment would constitutionally preserve the
5	right of a person to keep and bear arms for the defense of self,
