SENATE BILL No. 121

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AN ACT concerning health care; relating to reform in funding and structure of the federal and state programs.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. The legislature finds that affordable health care is a necessary part of a prosperous and healthy Kansas. The legislature further finds that in order to promote the prosperity of all Kansans, health insurance and health care must be made affordable. Private insurance may be the primary means of ensuring affordable costs, however, when health insurance and health care costs rise to unacceptable levels, the legislature finds that it is the role of government to provide health care that is reasonably cost-effective for the consumer and the health care provider. The legislature recognizes that the state rather than the federal government is better equipped to efficiently administer programs that are providing coverage for adequate health care, currently estimated to have a current annual cost of over \$3,500,000,000,000 at the state level.

Sec. 2. The governor and the Kansas health policy authority are hereby directed to request the federal government to grant all necessary waivers and exemptions from the prescribed uses of funding for medicaid, medicare, the federal employee retirements income security act of 1974, the state children's health insurance program and any other relevant federal law to provide for the transfer of the federal moneys provided to Kansas in the form of single annual block grant for the purpose of providing health care to the residents of Kansas.

Sec. 3. The governor, through the Kansas health policy authority, may enter into an agreement with the United States department of health and human services and the United States department of veterans affairs for the provision of health care benefits for those persons who would otherwise be eligible for medicaid, medicare, the state children's health insurance program, and veteran health benefits. The agreement shall outline a pilot project that will consolidate federal government health programs to a single-payer system that will provide health care and health promotion in a manner that is equitable and sustainable for consumers, providers, purchasers and government. The agreement and the pilot project contained therein shall continue for five federal fiscal years.

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1 Sec. 4. The coordinating federal health care fund is hereby created 2 in the state treasury. The coordinating federal health care fund shall be 3 administered by the Kansas health policy authority. After the granting of 4 all necessary federal waivers and exemptions, and upon acceptance of the agreement between all of the parties specified in section 3, and amend-6 ments thereto, the executive director of the Kansas health policy authority 7 shall deposit all funds received from the federal government under this 8 act into the coordinating federal health care fund. All expenditures from 9 the coordinating federal health care fund shall be in accordance with the 10 provisions of appropriation acts upon vouchers approved by the executive 11 director of the Kansas health policy authority or the executive director's 12 designee. The moneys credited to the coordinating federal health care 13 fund shall be used solely for the funding of those program benefits specified in the agreement authorized by section 3, and amendments thereto, 14 15 and such moneys shall not be used to replace or substitute for moneys 16 appropriated for the operating expenditures of the Kansas health policy 17 authority or any other agency of state government. 18

Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
