41 42 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 25-2425 is hereby amended to read as follows: 25-2425. (a) Voting machine fraud is: $\frac{\text{(a)}}{\text{(1)}}$ Being in unlawful or unauthorized possession of a voting machine key.

- (b) (2) Intentionally tampering with, altering, disarranging, defacing, impairing or destroying any voting machine, automatic ballot, voting machine label or register or record made by a voting machine.
 - (b) For the purposes of this section:
- (1) "Ballot" means a paper ballot on which candidates' names or questions are printed and which:
- (A) Is designed to receive opaque marks which can be detected by optical scanning equipment; and
 - (B) which is capable of being counted manually.

"Ballot" includes an electronic display or printed document containing the offices and questions on which voters in a specified voting area are eligible to vote.

- (2) "Counting location" means the location in the county selected by the county election officer for the automatic processing or counting, or both, of ballots.
- (3) "Direct recording electronic system" means a system that records votes by means of a ballot display provided with mechanical or electrooptical components that can be activated by the voter, that processes data
 by means of a computer program, that records voting data and ballot
 images in memory components, that produces a tabulation of the voting
 data stored in a removable memory component and as printed copy, and
 that may also provide a means for transmitting individual ballots or vote
 totals to a central location for consolidating and reporting results from
 precincts at the central location.
- (4) "Electronic or electromechanical voting system" means a system of casting votes by use of marking devices and tabulating ballots employing automatic tabulating equipment or data processing equipment including a direct recording electronic system.

- 1 (5) "Voting machine" means any device for the collection of votes 2 which has been approved and certified by the secretary of state pursuant 3 to K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 25-4404 and amendments thereto.
 - (c) Voting machine fraud is a severity level 10, nonperson felony.
- 5 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 25-2425 is hereby repealed.
- 6 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
