AN ACT concerning the display of the flag of the United States at half-12 13 staff. 1415Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 16 Section 1. (a) The flag of the United States shall be displayed at half-17staff throughout the state of Kansas in accordance with federal law including on a day designated by the governor when any of the following 1819occurs: 20(a) A member of the Kansas national guard is killed in the line of 21duty; 22 (b) a member of the Kansas air national guard is killed in the line of 23 duty: or -(e) a Kansas resident serving as a member of the United States armed 24 25forces is killed in the line of duty. on a day designated by the governor 26 to honor those members of the Kansas national guard, the Kansas 27air national guard and Kansas residents serving as members of the 28United States armed forces or the reserve forces killed in the line of 29 duty. Such day may be designated as the first Thursday of each 30 month. (b) On any day designated by the governor for displaying the 3132 flag of the United States at half-staff pursuant to this section, the 33 governor shall publish a list of those individuals described in sub-34 section (a) who were killed in the line of duty in the immediately 35 preceding month, unless an immediate family member of such in-36 dividual has submitted a request to the governor that such individ-37 ual's name not be included in such list. 38 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

39 publication in the statute book.
