10~ AN ACT concerning emergency medical services; criminal history record checks.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The emergency medical services board may shall require an original applicant for licensure to be fingerprinted and submit to a state and national criminal history record check. The fingerprints shall be used to identify the applicant and to determine whether the applicant has a record of criminal history in this state or other jurisdictions. The board is authorized to submit the fingerprints to the Kansas bureau of investigation and the federal bureau of investigation for a state and national criminal history record check. The board may use the information obtained from fingerprinting and the applicant's criminal history for purposes of verifying the identification of any applicant and in the official determination of character and fitness of the applicant for any licensure to practice emergency medical services in this state.

- (b) Local and state law enforcement officers and agencies shall assist the emergency medical services board in taking and processing of fingerprints of applicants to practice emergency medical services in this state and shall release all records of adult convictions and non-convictions and adult convictions or adjudications of another state or country to the emergency medical services board.
- (c) The board shall fix a fee for fingerprinting of applicants or licenses, or both, as may be required by the board in an amount necessary to reimburse the board for the cost of the fingerprinting. All such fees shall be credited in full to the *emergency medical services* criminal background and fingerprinting fund.
- (d) There is hereby created in the state treasury the *emergency medical services* criminal background and fingerprinting fund. All money credited to the fund shall be used to pay the Kansas bureau of investigation for the processing of fingerprints and criminal history background checks for the board of emergency medical services. The fund shall be administered by the board of emergency medical services. All expenditures from the fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts
