9 AN ACT concerning taxation; relating to levy of taxes; certification to 10 county clerk; amending K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 79-1801 and repealing the 11 existing section.

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Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 79-1801 is hereby amended to read as follows: 79-1801. (a) Except as provided by subsection (b), Each year the governing body of any city, the trustees of any township, the board of education of any school district and the governing bodies of all other taxing subdivisions shall certify, on or before August 25 October 1, to the proper county clerk the amount of ad valorem tax to be levied. Thereupon, the county clerk shall place the tax upon the tax roll of the county, in the manner prescribed by law, and the tax shall be collected by the county treasurer. The county treasurer shall distribute the proceeds of the taxes levied by each taxing subdivision in the manner provided by K.S.A. 12-1678a, and amendments thereto.

(b) In 2005, the board of education of any school district shall certify, on or before September 7, to the proper county clerk the amount of ad valorem tax to be levied.
