K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 79-32,117 is hereby amended to read 17as follows: 79-32,117. (a) The Kansas adjusted gross income of an indi-18vidual means such individual's federal adjusted gross income for the tax-19able year, with the modifications specified in this section. 20(b) There shall be added to federal adjusted gross income: 21Interest income less any related expenses directly incurred in the (i) 22 purchase of state or political subdivision obligations, to the extent that 23 the same is not included in federal adjusted gross income, on obligations 24 of any state or political subdivision thereof, but to the extent that interest 25income on obligations of this state or a political subdivision thereof issued 26prior to January 1, 1988, is specifically exempt from income tax under the 27 laws of this state authorizing the issuance of such obligations, it shall be 28excluded from computation of Kansas adjusted gross income whether or 29 not included in federal adjusted gross income. Interest income on obli-30 gations of this state or a political subdivision thereof issued after Decem-31ber 31, 1987, shall be excluded from computation of Kansas adjusted 32 gross income whether or not included in federal adjusted gross income. 33 (ii)Taxes on or measured by income or fees or payments in lieu of 34 income taxes imposed by this state or any other taxing jurisdiction to the 35 extent deductible in determining federal adjusted gross income and not 36 credited against federal income tax. amounts were subtracted from the federal adjusted gross income pursuant to paragraph (xv) of subsection (c) of K.S.A. 79-32,117, and amendments thereto, or if such amounts are not already included in the federal
adjusted gross income.

(xi) The amount of any contribution made to the same extent the
same is claimed as the basis for the credit allowed pursuant to K.S.A.
2008 Supp. 74-50,154, and amendments thereto.

43 (xii) For taxable years commencing after December 31, 2004,

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1 amounts received as withdrawals not in accordance with the provisions 2 of K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 74-50,204, and amendments thereto, if, at the time 3 of contribution to an individual development account, such amounts were 4 subtracted from the federal adjusted gross income pursuant to paragraph 5 (xiii) of subsection (c), or if such amounts are not already included in the 6 federal adjusted gross income.

as the basis for any credit allowed pursuant to K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 7932,223 through 79-32,226, 79-32,228 through 79-32,231, 79-32,233
through 79-32,236, 79-32,238 through 79-32,241, 79-32,245 through 7932,248 or 79-32,251 through 79-32,254, and amendments thereto.

(xvi) The amount of any amortization deduction claimed in determining federal adjusted gross income to the extent the same is claimed
for deduction pursuant to K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 79-32,227, 79-32,232, 79-32,237, 79-32,249, 79-32,250 or 79-32,255, and amendments thereto.

(xvii) The amount of any amortization deduction claimed in determining federal adjusted gross income to the extent the same is claimed
for deduction pursuant to K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 79-32,256, and amendments
thereto.

29 For taxable years commencing after December 31, 2006, the (xviii) 30 amount of any ad valorem or property taxes and assessments paid to a 31state other than Kansas or local government located in a state other than 32 Kansas by a taxpayer who resides in a state other than Kansas, when the 33 law of such state does not allow a resident of Kansas who earns income 34 in such other state to claim a deduction for ad valorem or property taxes 35 or assessments paid to a political subdivision of the state of Kansas in 36 determining taxable income for income tax purposes in such other state, 37 to the extent that such taxes and assessments are claimed as an itemized 38 deduction for federal income tax purposes.

(xxiii) For the taxable year in which any deduction for original issue 11 12 discount with respect to a debt instrument issued as part of reacquisition 13 of a debt instrument pursuant to subsection 108(i) of the federal internal revenue code deferred from a prior taxable year is claimed and allowed 1415on the taxpayer's federal income tax return and which amount has also 16been claimed and allowed as a subtraction modification pursuant to subsection (c)(xxiv) on the taxpayer's Kansas income tax return for such prior 1718taxable year, such claimed and allowed amount of deduction.

(c) There shall be subtracted from federal adjusted gross income:

(i) Interest or dividend income on obligations or securities of any
authority, commission or instrumentality of the United States and its possessions less any related expenses directly incurred in the purchase of
such obligations or securities, to the extent included in federal adjusted
gross income but exempt from state income taxes under the laws of the
United States.

(ii) Any amounts received which are included in federal adjusted
gross income but which are specifically exempt from Kansas income taxation under the laws of the state of Kansas.

29 (iii) The portion of any gain or loss from the sale or other disposition 30 of property having a higher adjusted basis for Kansas income tax purposes than for federal income tax purposes on the date such property was sold 3132 or disposed of in a transaction in which gain or loss was recognized for purposes of federal income tax that does not exceed such difference in 33 34 basis, but if a gain is considered a long-term capital gain for federal in-35 come tax purposes, the modification shall be limited to that portion of such gain which is included in federal adjusted gross income. 36

(iv) The amount necessary to prevent the taxation under this act of any annuity or other amount of income or gain which was properly included in income or gain and was taxed under the laws of this state for a taxable year prior to the effective date of this act, as amended, to the taxpayer, or to a decedent by reason of whose death the taxpayer acquired the right to receive the income or gain, or to a trust or estate from which the taxpayer received the income or gain. 1 (v) The amount of any refund or credit for overpayment of taxes on 2 or measured by income or fees or payments in lieu of income taxes im-3 posed by this state, or any taxing jurisdiction, to the extent included in 4 gross income for federal income tax purposes.

5 (vi) Accumulation distributions received by a taxpayer as a beneficiary 6 of a trust to the extent that the same are included in federal adjusted 7 gross income.

8 (vii) Amounts received as annuities under the federal civil service 9 retirement system from the civil service retirement and disability fund 10 and other amounts received as retirement benefits in whatever form 11 which were earned for being employed by the federal government or for 12 service in the armed forces of the United States.

(viii) Amounts received by retired railroad employees as a supplemental annuity under the provisions of 45 U.S.C. 228b (a) and 228c (a)(1)
et seq.

(ix) Amounts received by retired employees of a city and by retired
employees of any board of such city as retirement allowances pursuant to
K.S.A. 13-14,106, and amendments thereto, or pursuant to any charter
ordinance exempting a city from the provisions of K.S.A. 13-14,106, and
amendments thereto.

(x) For taxable years beginning after December 31, 1976, the amount
of the federal tentative jobs tax credit disallowance under the provisions
of 26 U.S.C. 280 C. For taxable years ending after December 31, 1978,
the amount of the targeted jobs tax credit and work incentive credit disallowances under 26 U.S.C. 280 C.

(xi) For taxable years beginning after December 31, 1986, dividend
income on stock issued by Kansas Venture Capital, Inc.

(xii) For taxable years beginning after December 31, 1989, amounts
received by retired employees of a board of public utilities as pension and
retirement benefits pursuant to K.S.A. 13-1246, 13-1246a and 13-1249
and amendments thereto.

(xiii) For taxable years beginning after December 31, 2004, amounts
contributed to and the amount of income earned on contributions deposited to an individual development account under K.S.A. 2008 Supp.
74-50,201, et seq., and amendments thereto.

36 (xiv) For all taxable years commencing after December 31, 1996, that 37 portion of any income of a bank organized under the laws of this state or 38 any other state, a national banking association organized under the laws 39 of the United States, an association organized under the savings and loan 40 code of this state or any other state, or a federal savings association organized under the laws of the United States, for which an election as an 41S corporation under subchapter S of the federal internal revenue code is 4243 in effect, which accrues to the taxpayer who is a stockholder of such

corporation and which is not distributed to the stockholders as dividends
 of the corporation.

3 (xv) For all taxable years beginning after December 31, 2006, amounts not exceeding \$3,000, or \$6,000 for a married couple filing a 4 joint return, for each designated beneficiary which are contributed to a $\mathbf{5}$ family postsecondary education savings account established under the 6 7 Kansas postsecondary education savings program or a qualified tuition program established and maintained by another state or agency or instru-8 9 mentality thereof pursuant to section 529 of the internal revenue code of 1986, as amended, for the purpose of paying the qualified higher edu-10 cation expenses of a designated beneficiary at an institution of postsecon-11 12dary education. The terms and phrases used in this paragraph shall have 13 the meaning respectively ascribed thereto by the provisions of K.S.A. 2008 Supp. 75-643, and amendments thereto, and the provisions of such 1415section are hereby incorporated by reference for all purposes thereof.

16(xvi) For the tax year beginning after December 31, 2004, an amount not exceeding \$500; for the tax year beginning after December 31, 2005, 1718an amount not exceeding \$600; for the tax year beginning after December 31, 2006, an amount not exceeding \$700; for the tax year beginning after 1920December 31, 2007, an amount not exceeding \$800; for the tax year 21beginning December 31, 2008, an amount not exceeding \$900; and for 22 all taxable years commencing after December 31, 2009, an amount not 23 exceeding \$1,000 of the premium costs for qualified long-term care insurance contracts, as defined by subsection (b) of section 7702B of public 24 25law 104-191.
