AN ACT concerning energy; relating to energy efficiency programs.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section:

- (1) "Commission" means the state corporation commission.
- (2) "Public utility" means any public utility defined in K.S.A. 66-104, and amendments thereto, and includes any municipally owned or operated utility and any cooperative, as defined in K.S.A. 17-4603, and amendments thereto, and any nonstock member-owned electric cooperative corporation.
- (b) Any public utility is hereby authorized to capitalize the reasonable costs incurred in operation of energy efficiency programs including, but not limited to, costs of equipment and personnel, and may earn a return on any such costs equal to the rate of return fixed for the utility's other investment in property found by the commission to be used or required to be used in the utility's services to the public.
- (c) The commission shall designate a third party who shall verify energy savings by the public utility on energy efficiency systems utilized by the utility's customers. Such public utilities shall pay such expenses associated with third party verification, which shall be assessed against such public utility by the commission.
- (d) The commission shall require an annual audit of each public utility's energy efficiency programs to determine the positive net benefit to customers. The commission shall disallow any return on investment which would otherwise be allowed pursuant to subsection (b) if the audit does not show a positive net benefit to the public utility's customers over a three-year period.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
