9 AN ACT regulating traffic; concerning distracted driving; amending 10 K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 8-2118 and repealing the existing section. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 New Section 1. (a) No person while driving a motor vehicle shall be 14so distracted as to interfere with the safe operation of such motor vehicle. 15 (b) For purposes of this section "distracted" shall include, but not 16limited to, reading, writing, performing personal grooming, interacting 17with pets or unsecured cargo, or engaging in any other activity which 18causes distractions. 19(c) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the uniform act 20regulating traffic on highways. 21Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 8-2118 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-2118. (a) A person charged with a traffic infraction shall, except 22 23 as provided in subsection (b), appear at the place and time specified in 24 the notice to appear. If the person enters an appearance, waives right to 25trial, pleads guilty or no contest, the fine shall be no greater than that 26specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs 27 shall be taxed as provided by law. 28(b) Prior to the time specified in the notice to appear, a person 29 charged with a traffic infraction may enter a written appearance, waive 30 right to trial, plead guilty or no contest and pay the fine for the violation 31as specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs 32 provided by law. Payment may be made by mail or in person and may be 33 by personal check. The traffic citation shall not have been complied with 34 if a check is not honored for any reason, or if the fine and court costs are 35 not paid in full. When a person charged with a traffic infraction makes 36 payment without executing a written waiver of right to trial and plea of 37 guilty or no contest, the payment shall be deemed such an appearance, 38 waiver of right to trial and plea of no contest. 39 (c) The following uniform fine schedule shall apply uniformly 40 throughout the state but shall not limit the fine which may be imposed 41following a court appearance, except an appearance made for the purpose

of pleading and payment as permitted by subsection (a). The description

(d) Traffic offenses classified as traffic infractions by this section shall
be classified as ordinance traffic infractions by those cities adopting
ordinances prohibiting the same offenses. A schedule of fines for all
ordinance traffic infractions shall be established by the municipal judge
in the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-4305, and amendments thereto.
Such fines may vary from those contained in the uniform fine schedule
contained in subsection (c).

(e) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection
(c) shall be doubled if a person is convicted of a traffic infraction, which
is defined as a moving violation in accordance with rules and regulations
adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 8-249, and amendments thereto, committed
within any road construction zone as defined in K.S.A. 8-1458a, and
amendments thereto.

(f) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and
amendments thereto, within two years after a prior conviction of K.S.A.
8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction
shall be fined 1½ times the applicable amount from one, but not both,
of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in
subsection (c). For a third violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and
amendments thereto, within two years, after two prior convictions of

1 K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be fined two times the applicable amount from one, but 2 3 not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c). For a fourth and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-4 1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, within two years after three $\mathbf{5}$ 6 prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, 7 such person, upon conviction shall be fined 21/2 times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform 8 9 fine schedule contained in subsection (c). 10 (g) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c) relating to exceeding the maximum speed limit, shall be doubled if a 11 12person is convicted of exceeding the maximum speed limit in a school 13 zone authorized under subsection (a)(4) of K.S.A. 8-1560, and 14amendments thereto. 15 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 8-2118 is hereby repealed.
