10 AN ACT concerning cities and counties; relating to residential fire pro-
11 tection sprinkler systems.

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

14 Section 1. As used in this act:

15 (a) "Municipality" means any city or county.

16 (b) "Residential structure" means any improvement to real property
17 to be used or occupied as a single-family dwelling or multi-family dwelling
18 of four attached living units or less **or any manufactured home.**

19 Sec. 2. On and after July 1, 2010, no municipality shall adopt or en-
20 force any ordinance, order, code, standard or rule requiring the installa-
21 tion of a multi-purpose residential fire protection sprinkler system or any
22 other fire sprinkler protection system in any residential structure. Nothing
23 in this section shall prohibit any person from voluntarily installing a multi-
24 purpose residential fire protection sprinkler system or any other fire
25 sprinkler protection system in a residential structure.

26 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
27 publication in the statute book.
