9 AN ACT concerning the liquor enforcement tax; relating to violations of such law; prescribing penalties therefor; licensees and persons required to be licensed.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The director of taxation or the director of alcoholic beverage control may enjoin any person from engaging in business in which such person is required to be licensed by the director of alcoholic beverage control when the person is in violation of any of the provisions of K.S.A. 79-4101 et seq., and amendments thereto, or any of the terms of this act, and shall be entitled in any proceeding brought for that purpose to have an order restraining the person from engaging in such business. No bond shall be required for any such restraining order or for any temporary or permanent injunction issued in that proceeding.

(b) If any licensee licensed by the director of alcoholic beverage control violates any of the provisions of K.S.A. 79-4101 et seq., and amendments thereto, or any of the terms of this act, the director of alcoholic beverage control may suspend or revoke the license of such licensee in accordance with K.S.A. 41-320, and amendments thereto, or may impose a civil fine on the licensee in the manner provided by K.S.A. 41-328, and amendments thereto, or both.

(c) The provisions of this section shall be part of and supplemental to the provisions of K.S.A. 79-4101 et seq., and amendments thereto.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
