Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

New Section 1. (a) As used in this section:

- "Wireless communication device" means any wireless electronic communication device that provides for voice or data communication between two or more parties, including, but not limited to, a mobile or cellular telephone, a text messaging device, a personal digital assistant that sends or receives messages, an audio-video player that sends or receives messages or a laptop computer.
- "Hands-free wireless communication device" means a wireless communication device that has an internal feature or function, or that is equipped with an attachment or addition, whether or not permanently part of such device, by which the user engages in a conversation without the use of either hand, except that this definition shall not preclude the use of either hand to activate, deactivate or initiate a function of the device.
- "Hands-free accessory" means an attachment, add-on, built-in feature or addition to a wireless communication device, whether or not permanently installed in a motor vehicle, that, when used, allows the motor vehicle operator to maintain both hands on the steering wheel.
- "Data communication" means a communication in the form of electronic text or one or more electronic images sent by a person from a telephone or computer to another person's telephone or computer by addressing the communication to the person's telephone number.
- Except as provided in subsection (c), it shall be unlawful for a person to use a wireless communication device for voice or data communications while driving a moving motor vehicle on a public road or highway in this state.
- (c) The provisions of subsection (b) shall not prohibit a person from using:
- A hands-free wireless communication device or hands-free accessory while driving a moving motor vehicle; or

- a handheld wireless communication device while driving a moving 2 motor vehicle:
 - During a medical emergency;
 - when reporting a safety hazard or requesting assistance relating to a safety hazard;
 - (C) when reporting criminal activity or requesting assistance relating to criminal activity;
 - when providing roadside or medical assistance; or
 - when used by a law enforcement officer or emergency service personnel acting within the course and scope of the law enforcement officer's or emergency service personnel's employment.
 - (d) The provisions of this section shall be applicable and uniform throughout the state and no city, county, subdivision or local authority shall enact or enforce any law, ordinance, rule, regulation or resolution in conflict with, in addition to or supplemental to the provisions of this section.
 - (e) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the uniform act regulating traffic on highways.
 - Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 8-2118 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-2118. (a) A person charged with a traffic infraction shall, except as provided in subsection (b), appear at the place and time specified in the notice to appear. If the person enters an appearance, waives right to trial, pleads guilty or no contest, the fine shall be no greater than that specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs shall be taxed as provided by law.
 - (b) Prior to the time specified in the notice to appear, a person charged with a traffic infraction may enter a written appearance, waive right to trial, plead guilty or no contest and pay the fine for the violation as specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs provided by law. Payment may be made by mail or in person and may be by personal check. The traffic citation shall not have been complied with if a check is not honored for any reason, or if the fine and court costs are not paid in full. When a person charged with a traffic infraction makes payment without executing a written waiver of right to trial and plea of guilty or no contest, the payment shall be deemed such an appearance, waiver of right to trial and plea of no contest.
 - (c) The following uniform fine schedule shall apply uniformly throughout the state but shall not limit the fine which may be imposed following a court appearance, except an appearance made for the purpose of pleading and payment as permitted by subsection (a). The description of offense contained in the following uniform fine schedule is for reference only and is not a legal definition.

- (d) Traffic offenses classified as traffic infractions by this section shall be classified as ordinance traffic infractions by those cities adopting ordinances prohibiting the same offenses. A schedule of fines for all ordinance traffic infractions shall be established by the municipal judge in the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-4305, and amendments thereto. Such fines may vary from those contained in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c).
- (e) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c) shall be doubled if a person is convicted of a traffic infraction, which is defined as a moving violation in accordance with rules and regulations adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 8-249, and amendments thereto, committed within any road construction zone as defined in K.S.A. 8-1458a, and amendments thereto.
- (f) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, within two years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be fined $1\frac{1}{2}$ times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c). For a third violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, within two years, after two prior convictions of

1 K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be fined two times the applicable amount from one, but 2 3 not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c). For a fourth and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-4 1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, within two years after three 6 prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be fined 2½ times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform 8 9 fine schedule contained in subsection (c).

- (g) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c) relating to exceeding the maximum speed limit, shall be doubled if a person is convicted of exceeding the maximum speed limit in a school zone authorized under subsection (a)(4) of K.S.A. 8-1560, and amendments thereto.

- Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
