13	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:
14	Section 1. K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 32-988 is hereby amended to read as
15	follows: 32-988. (a) The secretary is authorized to adopt, in accordance
16	with K.S.A. 32-805 and amendments thereto, rules and regulations fixing
17	the amount of fees for the following items, subject to the following lim-
18	itations and subject to the requirement that no such rules and regulations
19	shall be adopted as temporary rules and regulations:

- 2 Special events on department land or water: maximum \$200
- 3 Special departmental services, materials or supplies: no maximum
- 4 Other issues of department: no maximum
- Vendor bond: no maximum
  - (b) The fee for a landowner-tenant resident big game or wild turkey hunting permit shall be an amount equal to ½ the fee for a general resident big game or wild turkey hunting permit.
  - (c) The fee for a big game or wild turkey hunting permit for a resident under 16 years of age shall be an amount equal to ½ the fee for a general resident big game or wild turkey hunting permit.
- 12 (d) The fee for a furharvester license for a resident under 16 years 13 of age shall be an amount equal to ½ the fee for a resident furharvester 14 license.
  - (e) Any person who was held as a prisoner of war while serving in the army, navy, coast guard, air force or marine corps of the United States, shall be exempt from the license fees listed in subsection (a). The secretary shall exempt a person from the license fees listed in subsection (a) only after receiving sufficient documentation that the license applicant has been declared to be a prisoner of war, as established by the United States secretary of defense.
  - (f) The secretary may establish, by rules and regulations adopted in accordance with K.S.A. 32-805 and amendments thereto, different fees for various classes and types of licenses, permits, stamps and other issuances of the department which may occur within each item as described under subsection (a).
- 27 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 32-988 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
