AN ACT concerning state government; relating to the consolidation of information technology.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) The chief information technology architect shall conduct a study to evaluate the feasibility of information technology consolidation opportunities for the information technology architecture of the state. The feasibility study shall examine the possible consolidation of facilities, staff, applications, networks, disaster recovery operations, data centers, access methods and any other aspect of the state's information technology architecture that may be consolidated.

- (b) On or before August 1, 2010, the chief information technology architect shall submit the feasibility study to the council of chief information technology officers. The council shall consist of three members who shall be the chief information technology officers for the executive, judicial and legislative branches of the state. The council shall review the feasibility study. If the council approves any consolidation plan presented in the feasibility study, the council shall develop recommendations for strategic initiatives, conduct a cost-benefit analysis, calculate investment estimates and formulate implementation processes for such consolidation plan.
- (c) On or before September 1, 2010, the council of chief information technology officers shall submit any recommended consolidation plan, along with all other materials prepared by the council pursuant to subsection (b), to the information technology executive council.
- (d) The information technology executive council shall review any consolidation plan submitted by the council of chief information technology officers. If the information technology executive council approves any such consolidation plan, the chief information technology officers are hereby authorized to develop and implement any information technology project plan in accordance with K.S.A. 75-7201 et seq., and amendments thereto, that is necessary for implementation of the approved consolidation plan.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
