9 AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to bullying; amending 10 K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 72-8256 and repealing the existing section. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 72-8256 is hereby amended to read as 14follows: 72-8256. (a) As used in this section: 15 (1) "Bullying" means: (A) Any intentional gesture or any intentional 16written, verbal, electronic or physical act or threat that is sufficiently se-17vere, persistent or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening 18or abusive educational environment for a student or staff member that a 19reasonable person, under the circumstances, knows or should know will 20have the effect of: 21 Harming a student or staff member, whether physically or (i) 22mentally; 23 (ii) damaging a student's or staff member's property; placing a student or staff member in reasonable fear of harm to 24 (iii) 25the student or staff member; or 26 placing a student or staff member in reasonable fear of damage (iv)27 to the student's or staff member's property; 28(B) cyberbullying; or 29 any other form of intimidation or harassment prohibited by the (\mathbf{C}) 30 board of education of the school district in policies concerning bullying 31adopted pursuant to this section or subsection (e) of K.S.A. 72-8205, and 32 amendments thereto. 33 (2)"Cyberbullying" means bullying by use of any electronic com-34 munication device through means including, but not limited to, e-mail, 35 instant messaging, text messages, blogs, mobile phones, pagers, online 36 games and websites. 37 (3)"School vehicle" means any school bus, school van, other school 38 vehicle and private vehicle used to transport students or staff members 39 to and from school or any school-sponsored activity or event. 40 "Dating violence" means a pattern of behavior where one person (4)uses threats of, or actually uses, physical, sexual, verbal or emotional 4142abuse to control such person's dating partner. 43 (5)"Dating partner" means any person, regardless of gender, in1 volved in an intimate relationship with another primarily characterized

2 by the expectation of affectionate involvement whether casual, serious or3 long-term.

4 (b) (1) The board of education of each school district shall adopt a 5 policy to prohibit bullying on or while utilizing school property, in a school 6 vehicle or at a school-sponsored activity or event.

7 (e) (2) The board of education of each school district shall adopt and
8 implement a plan to address bullying on school property, in a school
9 vehicle or at a school-sponsored activity or event. Such plan shall include
10 provisions for the training and education for staff members and students.

(d) (3) The board of education of each school district may adopt additional policies relating to bullying pursuant to subsection (e) of K.S.A.
72-8205, and amendments thereto.

(c) (1) The board of education of each school district shall adopt a
policy to prohibit dating violence on or while utilizing school property,
in a school vehicle or at a school-sponsored activity or event.

(2) The board of education of each school district shall adopt and
implement a plan to address dating violence on school property, in a
school vehicle or at a school-sponsored activity or event. Such plan shall
include provisions for the training and education for staff members and
students.

(3) The board of education of each school district may adopt additional policies relating to dating violence pursuant to subsection (e) of
K.S.A. 72-8205, and amendments thereto.
