9 AN ACT establishing the chronic obstructive pulmonary disease pro-10 gram; providing for administration of the program by the secretary of 11 health and environment.

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42 43 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. (a) Within the limits of appropriations therefor, the secretary of health and environment shall establish the chronic obstructive pulmonary disease program to establish strategies for reducing the impact of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease and to coordinate efforts to assist persons with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease in this state, including, but not limited, the following:

- (1) Developing effective strategies for the prevention and early diagnosis of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease;
- (2) making recommendations to health care professionals concerning the treatment and management of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, including, without limitation, recommendations to increase access to non-pharmacologic therapies;
- (3) increasing public knowledge and awareness of chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, including, without limitations, the education of persons with chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, their families, health care professionals, providers of health care and the public on matters relating to chronic obstructive pulmonary disease; and
- (4) soliciting funding and other resources to ensure the continuation of the chronic obstructive pulmonary disease program and other programs which address issues relating to chronic obstructive pulmonary disease.
- (b) The secretary of health and environment may apply for and accept gifts, grants and bequests to carry out the provisions of this section.
- (c) The secretary of health and environment may adopt rules and regulations as necessary for the administration of the chronic obstructive pulmonary disease program.
- (d) There is hereby created in the state treasury the chronic obstructive pulmonary disease fund. The secretary of health and environment may accept moneys from any source for the financing of the chronic obstructive pulmonary disease program, and such moneys shall be re-

mitted to the state treasurer in accordance with K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the chronic obstructive pulmonary disease fund. All expenditures from the chronic obstructive pulmonary disease fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the secretary of health and environment or by a person or persons designated by the secretary.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
