## HOUSE BILL No. 2653

AN ACT regulating traffic; concerning United States postal service vehicles; amending K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 8-1520a and 8-2118 and repealing the existing sections.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

New Section 1. (a) The driver of a vehicle shall yield the right-ofway to any Untied States postal service vehicle which is obviously and actually engaged in the delivery or collection of mail upon a highway.

- (b) The driver of a motor vehicle upon approaching a stationary United States postal service vehicle which is obviously and actually engaged in the delivery or collection of mail upon a highway, shall do either of the following:
- (1) If the driver of the motor vehicle is traveling on a highway that consists of at least two lanes that carry traffic in the same direction of travel as that of the driver's motor vehicle, the driver shall proceed with due caution and, if possible and with due regard to the road, weather and traffic conditions, shall change lanes into a lane that is not adjacent to that of the stationary United States postal service vehicle; or
- (2) if the driver is not traveling on a highway of a type described in paragraph (1), or if the driver is traveling on a highway of that type but it is not possible to change lanes or if to do so would be unsafe, the driver shall proceed with due caution, reduce the speed of the motor vehicle and maintain a safe speed for the road, weather and traffic conditions.
- (d) From and after the effective date of this act and prior to July 1, 2011, a law enforcement officer shall issue a warning citation to anyone violating the provisions of this section.
- (e) This section shall not operate to relieve the driver of an United States postal service vehicle from the duty to drive with due regard for the safety of all persons using the highway.
- (f) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the uniform act regulating traffic on highways.
- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 8-1520a is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-1520a. (a) The driver of a vehicle shall not overtake and pass another vehicle when approaching within 100 feet of:
  - (1) A stationary authorized emergency vehicle on a highway that con-

sists of two lanes carrying traffic in opposite directions, when the authorized emergency vehicle is making use of visual signals meeting the requirements of K.S.A. 8-1720, and amendments thereto, or subsection (d) of K.S.A. 8-1722, and amendments thereto;  $\frac{1}{2}$ 

- (2) a stationary authorized vehicle which is obviously and actually engaged in work on a highway that consists of two lanes carrying traffic in opposite directions, when such vehicle displays flashing lights meeting the requirements of K.S.A. 8-1731, and amendments thereto; or
- (3) a stationary United States postal service vehicle which is obviously and actually engaged in the delivery or collection of mail on a highway.
- (b) From and after the effective date of this act, and prior to July 1,  $\frac{2007}{2011}$ , a law enforcement officer shall issue a warning citation to anyone violating the provisions of paragraph  $\frac{(2)}{2010}$  (3) of subsection (a).
- (c) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the uniform act regulating traffic on highways.
- Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 8-2118 is hereby amended to read as follows: 8-2118. (a) A person charged with a traffic infraction shall, except as provided in subsection (b), appear at the place and time specified in the notice to appear. If the person enters an appearance, waives right to trial, pleads guilty or no contest, the fine shall be no greater than that specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs shall be taxed as provided by law.
- (b) Prior to the time specified in the notice to appear, a person charged with a traffic infraction may enter a written appearance, waive right to trial, plead guilty or no contest and pay the fine for the violation as specified in the uniform fine schedule in subsection (c) and court costs provided by law. Payment may be made by mail or in person and may be by personal check. The traffic citation shall not have been complied with if a check is not honored for any reason, or if the fine and court costs are not paid in full. When a person charged with a traffic infraction makes payment without executing a written waiver of right to trial and plea of guilty or no contest, the payment shall be deemed such an appearance, waiver of right to trial and plea of no contest.
- (c) The following uniform fine schedule shall apply uniformly throughout the state but shall not limit the fine which may be imposed following a court appearance, except an appearance made for the purpose of pleading and payment as permitted by subsection (a). The description of offense contained in the following uniform fine schedule is for reference only and is not a legal definition.

- (d) Traffic offenses classified as traffic infractions by this section shall be classified as ordinance traffic infractions by those cities adopting ordinances prohibiting the same offenses. A schedule of fines for all ordinance traffic infractions shall be established by the municipal judge in the manner prescribed by K.S.A. 12-4305, and amendments thereto. Such fines may vary from those contained in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c).
- (e) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c) shall be doubled if a person is convicted of a traffic infraction, which is defined as a moving violation in accordance with rules and regulations adopted pursuant to K.S.A. 8-249, and amendments thereto, committed within any road construction zone as defined in K.S.A. 8-1458a, and amendments thereto.
- (f) For a second violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, within two years after a prior conviction of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be fined  $1\frac{1}{2}$  times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c). For a third violation of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, within two years, after two prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, such person, upon conviction shall be fined two times the applicable amount from one, but not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c). For a fourth and each succeeding violation of K.S.A. 8-

1 1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, within two years after three 2 prior convictions of K.S.A. 8-1908 or 8-1909, and amendments thereto, 3 such person, upon conviction shall be fined 2½ times the applicable 4 amount from one, but not both, of the schedules listed in the uniform 5 fine schedule contained in subsection (c).

- (g) Fines listed in the uniform fine schedule contained in subsection (c) relating to exceeding the maximum speed limit, shall be doubled if a person is convicted of exceeding the maximum speed limit in a school zone authorized under subsection (a)(4) of K.S.A. 8-1560, and amendments thereto.
- Sec. 4. K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 8-1520a and 8-2118 are hereby repealed. Sec. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
