9 AN ACT concerning the secretary of wildlife and parks; amending K.S.A. 102009 Supp. 32-801 and repealing the existing section. 11 12Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 32-801 is hereby amended to read as 14follows: 32-801. (a) In order to reorganize the administration, planning 15 and regulation of the state's parks, wildlife and other natural resources, 16there is hereby established within the executive branch of government 17the Kansas department of wildlife and parks, which shall be administered 18under the direction and supervision of a secretary of wildlife and parks 19who shall be appointed by the governor, with the consent of the senate 20as provided in K.S.A. 75-4315b, and amendments thereto. Except as pro-21vided by K.S.A. 46-2601, and amendments thereto, no person appointed 22 as secretary shall exercise any power, duty or function as secretary until 23 confirmed by the senate. The secretary shall be fully qualified by education, training and 24 (b) 25experience in wildlife, parks or natural resources, or a related field, and 26 shall have a demonstrated executive and administrative ability to dis-27charge the duties of the office of secretary. The secretary shall serve at 28the pleasure of the governor. The secretary shall be in the unclassified 29 service under the Kansas civil service act and shall receive an annual salary 30 to be fixed by the governor. 31 (c) The provisions of the Kansas governmental operations accounta-32 bility law apply to the Kansas department of wildlife and parks, and the 33 department is subject to audit, review and evaluation under such law. 34 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2009 Supp. 32-801 is hereby repealed. 35 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its 36 publication in the statute book.
