## **House Concurrent Resolution No. 5027**

10 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION endorsing Taiwan's participation as 11 an observer in the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) 12 and United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change 13 (UNFCCC). 1415 WHEREAS, Civil aviation plays a pivotal role in promoting cultural 16exchange, business, trade and tourism; and 17WHEREAS, The development of international civil aviation in a safe 18and orderly manner is the supreme cause of the International Civil Avi-19ation Organization (ICAO); and 20WHEREAS, Taiwan is the world's 20th largest economy, the 18th 21largest trading country and a key air transport hub linking Northeast and 22 Southeast Asia; and 23 WHEREAS, Over 174,000 international flights travel to and from Tai-24 wan, with foreign passengers making around 3.8 million trips to the island every year and over 35 million passengers, including 25.39 million pas-2526sengers on international flights, arrived and departed from Taiwan's air-27 ports in 2008; and 28WHEREAS, Without Taiwan's participation, international flight plans, 29 regulations and procedures that the ICAO formulates will be incomplete 30 and unsafe: Now, therefore, 31Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Kansas, 32 the Senate concurring therein: That the Kansas legislature endorses Tai-33 wan's participation in the International Civil Aviation Organization as an 34 observer; and 35 *Be it further resolved:* That the Kansas legislature is supportive of all 36 efforts to grant Taiwan official observer status at the United Nations 37 Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) because elimate 38 change has become a global challenge, as a collaborative partner of the 39 United States on a wide range of public issues, Taiwan should be afforded 40 the opportunity to participate in the global efforts aimed at reducing earbon emissions, preventing global warming and natural disasters; and 4142*Be it further resolved:* That copies of this resolution be sent to the 43 United States Secretary of State, the United States Secretary of Trans-
